



BEETHOVENFEST

The Molise Symphony Orchestra (O.S.M.) is pleased to announce the organization of BeethovenFest during the 2024 season. This event will showcase three productions dedicated to the piano concertos of Ludwig van Beethoven, encompassing all five Concertos and the Triple Concerto op.56. The soloists, selected through a public audition conducted by Maestro Michele Campanella, the visionary behind the project, will undergo a comprehensive training program led by Maestro Campanella himself. The culmination of the BeethovenFest journey will manifest in the performance of all six Concertos by the successful pianists, accompanied by the O.S.M. under the baton of Maestro Michele Campanella, scheduled for the months of October, November and December 2024.

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

Article 1– BeethovenFest is scheduled to take place in Campobasso during the months of September (for the study program only), October, November and December 2024. It constitutes three productions included in the O.S.M.'s 2024 schedule.

Article 2 – The BeethovenFest involves the study and performance of the six Beethoven Piano and Orchestra Concertos. The esteemed Maestro Michele Campanella will serve as the course instructor, selecting and preparing the soloists, conducting the O.S.M. in live performances.

Article 3 - To participate in the selection, candidates must perform one of Beethoven's Concertos, a Sonata chosen from op.2 to op.28, and a Sonata chosen from op.31 n.1 to op.111. Multiple concert applications are allowed, but successful candidates will be admitted to the course for the study and performance of a single composition. The selected pianists' names will be announced on the O.S.M. website.

Article 4 – Candidates must be under the age of 32 to participate in the selection.

Article 5 - The six selected soloists will engage in the study program as full-time students under Maestro Michele Campanella. Listeners are also welcome to attend the lessons.

Article 6 – The study program includes 12 hours of individual lessons with Maestro Campanella, 2 days of rehearsals before concerts with the O.S.M., as well as a pianist accompanist during the lessons.

Article 7 – The O.S.M. will engage the soloists chosen by Maestro Michele Campanella for BeethovenFest 2024. Additionally, it may organize repeats of individual programs.



Article 8 - The admission application, along with the required documents, must be submitted via email by 11:59 PM on Monday, April 8, 2024, to beethovenfestosm@gmail.com

Applications submitted after this deadline or to a different email address will not be considered.

The application must include :

- a completed application
- an artistic CV
- a copy of the identity document (passport for non-EU citizens)
- a copy of the €100.00 bank transfer (constituting the non-refundable registration fee), to the account held by Molise Symphony Orchestra - O.S.M Bank account, IBAN IT29C053870380000003557802 specifying "Registration fee for the BeethovenFest 2024 selection."

The subject of the email should be "BeethovenFest - Application," specifying the category for which you are participating: Participant or Listener.

By signing the application form, candidates fully and unconditionally accept the terms and conditions of this call for applications. For inquiries, contact beethovenfestosm@gmail.com.

Article 9 All applications received within the specified time and manner will be evaluated by Maestro Michele Campanella will evaluate, who will select candidates through a public audition in Campobasso on May 30 and 31, 2024. The audition details will be communicated by email.

The O.S.M. Secretariat will inform participants of the final audition time and convocation time with a 15-day notice. Participants are responsible for their travel, meals, and accommodation expenses. The O.S.M will arrange agreements with accommodation and catering facilities for the participating pianists in Campobasso.

Article 10 – Within 7 days of admission notification to BeethovenFest 2024, selected candidates must complete the registration process using forms available on the O.S.M. website. The completed registration form, along with a copy of the payment, made to the Molise Symphony Orchestra (please see above bank details), must be sent via email to beethovenfestosm@gmail.com.

- €500,00 for all lessons and orchestra rehearsals

* Observer enrollment fees must be paid 7 (seven) days before the start of the lesson.
